Background Information

The aim of the scheme which operates internationally is to recognise, encourage and support young people who are actively involved in the welfare of the community. This is likely to include involvement in helping young and older people, disabled people of all ages, conservation, crime prevention, promoting healthier lifestyles, hospital radio, youth organisations, mentoring, and other initiatives.

Through the scheme, Lion, Leo and Lioness clubs sponsor selected young people who have demonstrated a commitment to the Lions' ideal of service to the community.

For candidates who are entered to compete at Europa Forum for the Young Ambassador of the 21st Century European Award, there are first, second and third place bursaries awarded of 3,500 Euros, 1,000 Euros and 500 Euros.

The European Final will be organised by the Europa Forum Host Committee and support will additionally come from the European committee, comprising a representative from the host countries from the past year, current year and two forthcoming years, plus two invited additional members. The Committee Chairman is appointed by the European Council at Europa Forum and will be in office for 3 years.
